RE Inspection

As you are aware, we were recently inspected by the Archdiocese of Liverpool who looked at the quality of Religious Education provided by our school. The inspection looked at 9 areas of school life, with each being graded individually and then a final overall grade being awarded. We are delighted to say that our school received an 'Outstanding' grade for all nine areas, plus an 'Outstanding' grade overall! This is the highest award that can be given to a school and we are all rightly proud of this. It would not be possible without the dedication of all staff and volunteer helpers, pupils and of course yourselves and all members of the St Elizabeth's community. We are still awaiting the final report and will provide you with access to this once it is available.
